Partner meeting in Pecs, Hungary

The 3rd transnational workshop took place in Pecs, Hungary from 11.-12 October 2010. The workshop was attended by partner organisations and experts in education & training from Germany, Switzerland, Scotland, Lithuania, Romania, Sweden and Hungary.

Previous to the workshop in the partner countries a series of stakeholder consulations were conducted, in order to identify quality issues in education and training and answers provided by learning regions and cities. From the findings a draft quality framework was derived, indicating criteria and indicators towards the building of quality learning regions and cities throughout Europe.

On the occasion of the workshop the draft framework was discussed in detail in the light of the European strategy on quality in education and training. Through the next months the framework will be finetuned and tested in selected European learning regions and cities.
